After finishing a packed tour of the renowned Australian Clubs and a short tour of New Zealand, Horsburgh will be returning to the States to take part in Silver Dollar City's International World Festival.

He is also looking forward to a very busy American tour schedule which includes a Saturday performance at Hodag in Rhinelander.
