Wayne Horsburgh wins "Male Country Performer of The Year" in the Australian Entertainment 'MO' Awards. The event took place in Sydney on June 17.

This makes Wayne's fifth 'MO' Award and proves that his home country popularity is still strong, despite spending more than half of each year in the USA and traveling the world.

"I was delighted to get this news from back home" says Wayne. "It proves that my more traditional style of country music is still popular in Australia".

Wayne was in Nashville, Tennessee, when he got a phone call about the good news from backstage at the awards ceremony in Sydney.

With two Australian Club Entertainment (ACE) Awards this international entertainer can be proud of the title seven times during his long career in Country Music.

A new CD project, Born Free, has just been released by Horsburgh. The album features 16 love songs from the '50s and '60s, incorporating the style of Andy Williams, Bobby Vinton, Al Martino and Dean Martin.

It also includes a re-recording of Horsburgh's popular song, Lovers Carousel.

Wayne travels to Sandstone, Minnesota early in September to appear on MidWest Country Theatre, which will be broadcast out to 35 million US viewers on RFD-TV channel.

In the meantime, Wayne is based in Branson, Missouri during the American summer months and will be performing at Silver Dollar City in September and October with the HorseCreek Band during the "Salute To The Great American Cowboy" Festival.

He then returns to Australia in November for a tour of Tasmania, South Australia and Victoria as well as his regular performances in the Sydney clubs.
